Triangle Scarf

Stitch up a variety of these “Triangle Scarves”, from your scraps! They are great to have handy for a windy day or as a gift for those hard to buy for friends!

Sewing Supplies:

1/2 yard cotton fabric
1 pkg. Double fold Bias tape
Sewing thread



1. Cut one square 15" X 15".
2. Cut square diagonally to form (2) triangles 15" X 15" X 21"
3. Place triangles right sides together.
4. Stitch the two 15" sides, using the edge of your foot as a guide.
5. Clip the corner, turn and press.
6. Straight stitch near the raw edges of the remaining side of the triangle, to hold them together.
7. Cut a piece of bias tape 41" long. Open out the bias tape. Find the middle, and pin it to the middle of the 21" edge, matching the raw edges.
8. Stitch on the fold of the bias tape nearest the raw edges, through all the layers.
9. Fold the bias tape to the other side of the scarf.
10. Begin at the end of the tie, folding it in half. Stitch the tie, continue across the scarf, and complete the other tie.
